

ARTS TOWER
SHEFFIELD

One of the most famous International styled buildings in the country, The Arts Tower at Sheffield University is a quarter scale replica of the Seagram Building in New York. The Arts Tower has undergone a major makeover to modernise and expand the predicted lifespan by 30 years. The Tower remains a heritage grade II listed building and has maintained its status as the tallest University building in the UK since it opened in 1965. The original colour scheme was incorporated into the re-cladding and replacement windows.
